- G.S.R. 910.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All-India Radio (Class II Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1962, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R. 347, dated the 6th March, 1962, namely—
- 1. (1) These rules may be called the All-India Radio (Class II Posts) Recruitment (Third Amendment) Rules, 1968.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette
- 2. In the Schedule to the All-India Radio (Class II Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1962, for the entries in column 122 against Serial No. 17 relating to "Accounts Officer" the following shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "Transfer on deputation of officers of the rank of Assistant Accounts Audit Officer, failing which S.A.S. Accountant with 5 years' service as such, from any of the organised Accounts Department for example, Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Indian Defence Accounts Department, Indian Railway Accounts Department, Post and Telegraph Accounts Department.

- G.S.R. 912.—In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act. 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Petroleum Products (Supply and Distribution) Order, 1966, namely:—
- 2. This Order may be called the Petroleum Products (Supply and Distribution) Amendment Order, 1968
- 3. In the Petroleum Products (Supply and Distribution) Order, 1966 in waragraph 3, for sub-paragraph (2) and the provisos, the following sub-paragraph and provisos shall be substituted:
- '(2) Every Officer in charge of any main port installation or depot, shall, on receipt of the petroleum product or products supplied by any oil distributing company whether in pursuance of an Order made under sub-paragraph (1), or otherwise, distribute the same in the Supply area concerned:

Provided that the Central Government may, at any time, issue such directions to the officer in charge of a depot or main port installations as may be necessary for the equitable distribution of such product or products:
