G.S.R. 1393.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Information Service Rules, 1959, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R.-217 (CIS), dated the 16th February, 1959, namely:—

1. (i) These rules may be called the Central Information Service (7th Amendment) Rules, 1968.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In Schedule VIII of the Central Information Service Rules, 1959, in subparagraph (b) of paragraph 1, in "Part II (viva-voce)", for the figures and word "200 marks", the figures and word "100 marks" shall be substituted.

G.S.R. 1394.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Radio (Class III posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R. 1778, dated the 30th November, 1964, namely:—

- (1) These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class III posts) Recruitment (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 1968.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
