G.S.R. 2780.—The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Textiles Committee Rules, 1965, which the Central Government proposes to make in exercise of the power conferred by section-22 of the Textiles Committee Act, 1963, (No. 41 of 1963), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of the said section for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into-consideration on or after the 10th January, 1970.

Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person or organisation with respect to the said draft before the date aforesaid will be considered by the Central Government.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

जी० एस० आर० 2785:—संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के उपबन्ध द्वारा प्रदत्त अधिकारों का प्रयोग करते हुए, राष्ट्रपति भारत सरकार के सूचना और प्रसारण मंत्रालय की अधिसूचना संख्या जी० एस० आर० 1776, तारीख 30 नवम्बर, 1964 में प्रकाशित आकाशवाणी (तृतीय श्रेणी पद) भर्ती नियमावली, 1964 में अतिरिक्त संशोधन करने के लिये एतद्वारा निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं :

1. (1) इन नियमों को आकाशवाणी (तृतीय श्रेणी पद) भर्ती (सातवां संशोधन) नियमावली, 1964 कहा जा सकेगा।

(2) ये नियम सरकारी राजपत्र में प्रकाशित होने की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

G.S.R. 2786.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Publications Division (Class I Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1969 published with the Notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R. 2745 dated the 15th October, 1969, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Publications Division (Class I Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1969.
2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

3. In the Schedule to the Publications Division (Class I Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1969, for the existing entries in Columns 9, 11, 12, 13 and 14, against the item "Business Manager", the following shall be substituted, namely:—

G.S.B. 2787.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 141 of the Border Security Force Act, 1968 (47 of 1968), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Border Security Force (Assistant Commandants) Recruitment Rules, 1969.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Recruitment of Assistant Commandants.**—(1) Subject to the provisions contained in the Border Security Force Rules, 1969 the recruitment to the posts of Assistant Commandants in the Border Security Force shall be made in any of the following manners, namely:—

- (i) by transfer on deputation from the rank of Captain from the Army or Assistant Superintendent of Police or Deputy Superintendent of Police from the State Governments, or
- (ii) by transfer on deputation (by promotion) of officers holding the posts of Inspector of Police or equivalent posts, having held such post for a period of three years in any Central or State Police organisation; or
- (iii) by promotion of Subedars (Inspectors) of the Border Security Force, who have not completed the age of 50 years, and—
 - (a) in the case of ex-Emergency Commissioned Officers have held such post for a period of not less than two years; and
 - (b) in any other case have held such post in any Central or State Armed Police Force for a period of not less than three years; or
- (iv) by direct recruitment from amongst candidates who possess the following qualifications, namely:—
 - (a) have attained the age of 19 years and have not attained the age of 25 years on the 1st day of July of the year of recruitment;
