G.S.R. 399.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Radio (Class III Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R. 1776, dated the 30th November, 1964, namely:—

1. (i) These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class III Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1968.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the All India Radio (Class III Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, after Serial No. 47 and the entries relating thereto, the following shall be inserted, namely:—

G.S.R. 400.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 71E of the Indian Railways Act, 1950 (9 of 1950), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Railway Servants (Hours of Employment) Rules, 1961, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Railway, Servants (Hours of Employment) Amendment Rules, 1968.

2. In the Railway Servants (Hours of Employment) Rules, 1961, in sub-rule (1) of rule 5, after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(d) Bungalow Peons residing at or close to the place of work.”
