**G.S.R. 1293.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 809 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Librarian (Ministry of Home Affairs) Recruitment Rules, 1960 published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. G.S.R. 207, dated the 23rd February 1960, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Librarian (Ministry of Home Affairs) Amendment Rules, 1963.

2. In the Schedule to the Librarian (Ministry of Home Affairs) Rules, 1960, for the entries relating to item "7. Method of recruitment", the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"7. Method of recruitment.—By transfer or deputation or promotion or by direct recruitment, as may be considered desirable."

**G.S.R. 1294.**—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 7 of the Indian Police Service (Probation) Rules, 1954, the Central Government, in consultation with the State Governments and the Union Public Service Commission, hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Indian Police Service (Probationers' Final Examination) Regulations, 1959, namely:—

1. These regulations may be called the Indian Police Service (Probationers' Final Examination) Amendment Regulations, 1963.

2. In the Indian Police Service (Probationers' Final Examination) Regulations, 1959, in regulation 5, the entry at item 4 shall be omitted and item (5) shall be renumbered as item (4).

1. These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class II Posts) Recruitment Second Amendment Rules, 1963.
