G.S.R. 2068.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the National Academy of Administration (Class II Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1961, namely:—

- (1) These rules may be called the National Academy of Administration (Class II Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1968.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the National Academy of Administration (Class II Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1961. Serial No 1 'Administrative Officer' and the entries there against shall be omitted and entries 2, 3 and 4 shall respectively be renumbered as 1, 2 and 3.

G.S.R. 2077.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Regional Office, Jute Development (Class I and II posts) Recruitment Rules, 1968.

1. (1) These rules may be called the Regional Office, Jute Development (Class I and II posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1968.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Regional Office, Jute Development (Class I and II posts) Recruitment Rules, 1968, in the entry relating to serial No. 10, in column 11, for the existing entry under the heading "Transfer on deputation", the following entry shall be substituted, namely:—

"Permanent assistants of the Central Secretariat Service with five years' service in the grade".

(Period of deputation: two years extendable to three years.)"

G.S.R. 2078.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the All India Radio (Recruitment of Deputy Director General, All India Radio) Rules, 1962, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the All India Radio (Recruitment of Deputy Director General, All India Radio) Amendment Rules, 1968.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the All India Radio (Recruitment of Deputy Director General, All India Radio) Rules, 1962, Serial No. 1 and 2 and the entries relating thereto shall be omitted.
